7. A.O.B

LAA - As part of the Worthing Outcome 22 Action Plan, £2,000 has been allocated to set up a Healthy Walk in East Worthing in 07/08 (possibly linking it to the Off Road Link). The money will pay for equipment, training and publicity of the walk, with the aim of improving people's health.
Healthy Walking - The PCT have some money to develop a range of leaflets based on the current healthy walks scheme in Worthing. The leaflet will map the route and the distance walked, give advice on health benefits and have a guide to walking safely.
